

**Marysville Borough Sewer Committee**

**Minutes**

1. Ordinance 570: Rehabilitation Rate versus Vacancy Rate - Robert Sultzaberger

Questions raised: Walker, Mohr, Stepler, Sultzaberger, Allander

Brian discussed the rehabilitation rate ordinance and how some residents have been on the rehabilitation rate for over the one year permitted period. The committee suggested that the ordinance be adjusted to permit the rate one year with a renewal option after the one year. After the two year period, a resident would need to pay the reconnect fee.

2. Carole Murray - would like rate reduced to residential rate.  
Resident currently paying Home1 rate / sewer \$230.10 / trash \$76.00

Committee discussed reducing Carole Murray's account to the residential rate since no additional trash or sewer is being generated in conjunction with the business. The committee will make a recommendation to council on Monday evening to reduce the rate. Also, Resolution 214 is in the process of being adjusted to reflect the rate in other home occupations.

3. Termination of water service

Brian informed the committee that Dan Altland indicated that if necessary, the borough can direct United Water to terminate water service for an unpaid sewer account.

4. Sewer Capital Reserve Funds.

Ann discussed the sanitary sewer separation in the square area and asked the committee to consider using sewer capital reserve fund monies to pay for the \$150,000 projected estimate. The importance of separating the system before the revitalization occurs is imperative to avoid digging up the improved surface in the future.
