Minutes

1. Deer Crossing Signs Due to concerns regarding deer crossing on Kings Highway, I would like the approval to install 2 signs on Kings Highway.

Committee recommended the signs be installed.

2. Mary Ellen Kocher Since parking is permitted on the west side of Bittings Alley, Mary is requesting a handicap parking sign. I originally informed her that the committee did not want to issue the sign since there was no parking on Bittings Alley, however, there is parking on west side.

The committee recommended that Ordinance 553 be amended to restrict parking on the east and west side of Bittings Alley. The handicap parking request was rejected.

3. SALDO Waiver The committee will need to recommend a waiver from Ordinance 496, Part 7, Section 22-705, 6B, to Borough Council reducing the minimum distance between units from 25' to 15'. This will be required in order to allow the Trout Run project to take place.

4. Street Light Audit Put on the agenda per the last council meeting.

Committee recommended Brian contact PPL for replacement of bulbs throughout the borough.

5. SS – Deer Trail / KH A stop sign has been requested on Kings Highway in the area of Whitetail Crossing.

Committee recommended Brian amend Ordinance 553 to install stop intersections at Kings Highway and Antler Drive and also Kings Highway and Deer Trail.

6. Amanda Foster Inquired about the borough property located at the intersection of Front Street and Route 11/15.

Committee recommended Brian contact Amanda to inform her that any borough property being sold would need to be put out for bid and that he will inform the council of her interest.

7. Wendy Gauker Interested in having the borough close the unopened road adjacent to her property.

Committee recommend Brian inform her that she would need to have her attorney complete the necessary process for vacating an unopened road.
