**1. Engineering Results for Paving/Reconstructing Two Streets
(Park Drive, Ridgeview Drive)**

Dave started off the meeting with asking members what their thoughts are for putting off the streets project for one year and building the pole building to store the equipment that is sitting out in the weather. After some discussion the committee thought this is the way to go. Dave said the finance committee will look at these items and come up with a plan on what the borough can afford at this time.

2. Letter to Residence about Curb Replacement

Scott reported that the letter to the residence went out on Thursday, June 30th. Scott has received a couple calls on them. In the letter it was said that we may not do the streets project until 2018 due to not having the funds. That will give the residence an extra year to get there curbs in compliance.

3. Boat Ramp

Scott informed the committee that the boat ramp washes out every time we get a heavy rain event. Our crew then has to take the equipment up and replace the stone and gravel. Scott and Ken talked about placing blacktop in that area to stop the washout and to keep the stone out of Mr. Webster's yard and washing into the river. We would do this one load at a time and spread the blacktop with the skid steer and level it by hand. Then roll it into place. While placing a small curb on Mr. Webster side to keep the excess water out of his yard. The committee's thought would be to use Park and Rec funds to pay for the blacktop.

4. Cassell Street

The committee would like to consider paving the section from where we stopped before to the Bitting Ave area. Scott said he would check with East Penn to see if we can get there paver for one day and get this completed. Dave said why pay to have the rock wall repaired if the street will not support it. The road needs proper drainage and extensions on the pipes in place to stop the washout of the bank below the rock wall.

5. Kings Highway at Boyer's

Allen stated that the road is sinking again and that we need to repair the road before it gets out of control. Scott will take a look at it and schedule the guys to take care of it.
